INSTRUCTIONS ON SCORING STUDENTS

Each topic gets a score ranging from 1 (excellent), 2 (very good), 3 (good), 4 (average), 5 (fair), 6 (poor)

Background- Student provides adequate background to set the stage of the study.

Objectives/hypothesis- Hypothesis to be tested or objectives of study are clearly presented.

Methods- Methods are adequate to address objectives or to test hypothesis

Results- Results relate back to methodology and are clearly presented

Conclusions- Conclusions are sound and supported by data

Slides- Slides are well organized, logical, easily read, and interpreted

Style- Delivery is clear, audible, with proper elocution and suitable eye contact with audience.

Innovation- Study involves a novel approach or addresses a novel topic.
