



Call for Emeritus Award Nominations 2023

The Awards Committee is seeking nominations for the Emeritus Award.

The Emeritus Award is an honorary category of membership designed to acknowledge a lifetime of dedication and service. It is bestowed by Council on a member who has retired from their profession and who, in the opinion of Council, has significantly contributed to the study of wildlife and ecosystem health anywhere in the world and consistently supported the mission and values of the WDA. Although the award need not be presented every year, we strongly encourage you to nominate deserving candidates.

Emeritus members enjoy the same rights and privileges as a regular member without further payment of dues.

The closing date for nominations is **April 15th, 2023**.

Nominations should include the following:

- a) Letter of nomination specifically addressing the selection criteria for the award that are not otherwise represented in the candidate's CV including that the candidate:
 - Is retired.
 - Has demonstrated significant contributions to the field of wildlife or ecosystem health, research or management throughout their career.
- b) Candidate's curriculum vitae or equivalent.
